What does the 3M™ Filtek™ Matrix procedure require?

Treatment typically includes two appointments. At your first appointment the dentist will take photos and a digital or physical impression of your teeth. At the next appointment, your doctor will use the Filtek Matrix and you will walk out with your new smile.

Will the procedure hurt?

In many cases, use of the Filtek Matrix does not require anesthesia. Your dentist will determine clinical need based on your dental situation.
